


Our Place St Aidan's School

Term 3 Week 6 Friday 25th August 2017




Students (as well as adults) move through 'the learning pit' as they strive to understand and learn something new.



Being on Time

Attendance is not just about being at school but also about being on time. Being late 5 minutes a day equals 25 minutes over a week, 250 minutes a term or 4 hours per term, or the equivalent of 3-4 days per year and over the schooling years is equivalent to one whole term of missed learning time. When a student arrives late they have often missed the introduction to a lesson and they have missed time socialising with their peers.
