


A list of staff and important dates for the term are included in this newsletter.

## **Supervision**

- Gates are opened and teacher supervision begins at 8:15am
- Parents may escort their children onto the playground but are required to wait in the parent waiting area (silver seats) near the year four classroom due to child protection
- The bell is rung at 8:45am—students walk quietly to lines
